  - a. Teresa shared the results for the Division Provincial Achievement Testing as well as the Isabel Campbell Achievement Testing. A discussion followed regarding the performance trends and areas for improvement. It was noted that the Grade 6 Provincial Exam results will be mailed directly to students' homes for parental review. A Professional Learning Day was held in December, where teachers participated in various development sessions aimed at improving educational practices and student outcomes.
